Innovative New Technology from SAFETY QUICK LIGHT LLC Revolutionizes Installation of Hard-Wired Fixtures and Fans

ROSWELL, GA – July 11, 2006 – Installing or changing light fixtures and ceiling fans can now be done as safely, quickly and easily as changing a light bulb, thanks to an innovative, awarding-winning new connection device offered by Safety Quick Light LLC (SQL). With the SQL system, hard-wired lighting fixtures and ceiling fans no longer require complicated wiring and installations. New lighting fixtures or fans with the SQL connection device pre-installed allows homeowners to simply plug in the fixture or fan as easily as plugging in a table lamp.

The SQL patented device provides both the electrical and mechanical connection in one system, and fits all wall and ceiling canopies. The device consists of two parts – a female receptacle which installs into all junction boxes, and a male plug which is pre-installed in the lighting fixture. The connection device allows for safe, quick and easy installation of lighting fixtures and ceiling fans, and eliminates the restrictions associated with permanent connection. Once the female receptacle is installed in the outlet box, the lighting fixture or ceiling fan requires no additional wiring for installation, and the receptacle never has to be replaced. The fixture or fan plugs into the receptacle as simply as a table lamp. Any fixture and fan with an SQL male plug can be used with the installed receptacle, making cleaning, replacement, or seasonal décor changes fast and trouble-free. The system can be used on fixtures rated for indoor or outdoor use.

“We are very pleased to offer this brand new technology to both the lighting industry and to consumers,” says Rani Kohen, President and CEO of Safety Quick Light LLC. “The SQL connection system will revolutionize lighting as we know it today. This technology makes it simple and convenient for everyone from homeowners to

building contractors to safely install and remove lighting fixtures and ceiling fans quickly. We're making the limitations associated with traditional, hard-wired fixtures a thing of the past," he notes.

Lighting fixtures and ceiling fans with SQL install in three easy steps:

1. Install Female receptacle in electrical outlet box. Push-in terminals are provided for making the electrical connection.
2. Line up fixture/fan with pre-installed SQL to the female receptacle in the outlet box.
3. Press release button on fixture canopy, insert male plug into the receptacle connector and "click." Installation is complete.

The SQL device is available as a complete system in which the male plug is pre-installed into the lighting fixture or ceiling fan. A conversion kit to retro-fit existing fixtures and fans is also available. Lighting fixtures and fans with SQL will be marketed by Design Home Solutions, a Ft. Lauderdale-based lighting distributor supplying retailers in both the US and Canada and Canarm. The SQL device is both UL-listed and CSA approved.
