



UL EVALUATES AND LISTS AN INNOVATIVE, AWARD-WINNING PRODUCT BY SAFETY QUICK LIGHT LLC

***Unique Concept from SAFETY QUICK LIGHT
Likely to Gain Quick Acceptance in the Field***

ROSWELL, GA – AUGUST 8, 2006 – A new quick-connect lighting device from Safety Quick Light LLC is so innovative that Underwriters Laboratories (UL) faced a unique challenge in determining how to categorize, list and test the product. After two years and three rounds of UL review, the Safety Quick Light (SQL) finally received UL Listing this year. The SQL system allows hard-wired lighting fixtures and ceiling fans to be installed as safely, quickly, and easily as plugging in an ordinary table lamp.

The patented SQL device provides both the electrical and mechanical connection in one system and fits all wall and ceiling canopies. The two-part device consists of a *female receptacle* (listed under UL's category RTRT) which installs into any junction box, and a *male plug* (covered as a UL Component under AXUT2) which is pre-installed into lighting fixtures. The receptacle features push-in terminals to make the electrical connection allow for simple installation. Once the female receptacle is installed, it never has to be replaced. Any fixture with an SQL male plug can be used with the installed receptacle, and fixtures can be connected to the receptacle while live.

UL was first approached by Safety Quick Light in 2003. The initial round of review consisted of an internal review to obtain comments from the head engineers in the Lighting, Fans, and Receptacle Devices departments. The device was next submitted to UL's 40-member Electrical Council, comprised of 40 separate Authorities Having Jurisdiction (AJHs) also referred to as the head state inspectors. Pictures and detailed production information on the original SQL device were submitted to the

entire Electrical Council to determine whether the system would be accepted in the field.

Following this second round of review, the primary designated engineers in charge of the UL standard from each impacted category, including Lighting (1598), Receptacles (498), and Fans (507), held a video conference with Safety Quick Light in November 2004. SQL then submitted production-ready samples with all markings to the Electrical Council for comment a second time. The Council confirmed their acceptance of the device in late December 2005.

With the three rounds of review complete in January 2006, the testing phase for Listing was initiated. The SQL device as a component was tested to three different UL standards: UL 498 (receptacles); UL 355 (cord reels); and UL 514A (outlet boxes). End-product devices such as lighting fixtures and ceiling fans with the SQL component installed will be evaluated to their associated standards, UL 507 (fans) and UL 1598 (lighting).

"Every day, our customers develop new and ingenious solutions to a variety of end-user needs," said Eli M. Puszkar, Lighting SBU General Manager, UL. "For us at UL it is both an honor and a challenge to be able to play a part in the process of innovation. We are committed to help customers like Safety Quick Light develop safe products, and to this end, we continuously rely on our broad and extensive experience in order to keep up with their ever-changing needs as they endeavor to improve our world."

"We are very pleased that more than two years of review and testing resulted in the UL Listing for our product," said Rani Kohen, inventor of the SQL device, and

President and CEO of Safety Quick Light LLC. "After such exhaustive review, there is no doubt that the SQL device is extremely safe and so clearly innovative that it withstood the most intense scrutiny against industry standards. We are proud to have introduced such a pioneering new technology and look forward to transforming the lighting industry with it," he concluded.

Lighting fixtures and ceiling fans with the Safety Quick Light feature are being marketed by Design Home Solutions, a Ft. Lauderdale-based lighting distributor (supplying retailers in both the US and Canada), and Canarm.
